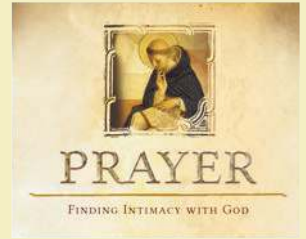
A huge thank you to all who attended the annual "tie-blanket making" day. Your hard work allowed St. Joseph to donate twenty-six blankets to children in our community.

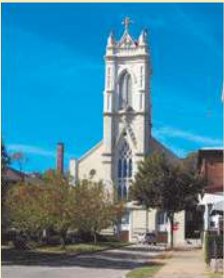
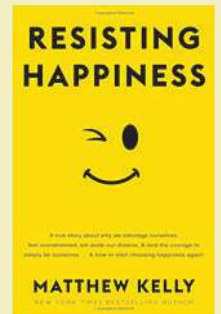
