



The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary— which occurs on December 8th and celebrates the Blessed Virgin conceived without Original Sin, is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Mass times are:

- December 7th at 6 PM.
- December 8th at 9:15 AM.

Blessing of a Mother Before Child Birth after Weekend Masses December 10 and 11—All Moms expecting a child are invited to gather with their families for a blessing at the devotional area of the church graced by the statues of the Blessed Mother, Jesus and St. Joseph, which is near the Brockman Ave., entryway of the church. The blessing will occur after Mass and when I've finished greeting departing worshippers.

While this blessing can happen any time before childbirth, we schedule this special time during Advent in proximity to the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe (December 12th), Patroness of the Americas and the Unborn, who was pregnant when she appeared to St. Juan Diego. The blessing is bestowed upon the mother before the birth of her child in celebration of her maternity, for a healthy gestation of her child and safety in delivery and in praise of God for the gift of new life.

Advent Confessions—Advent is a season of devout and expectant delight in preparation for the celebration of Christmas and the return of Jesus at the end of time. In the spirit of devotion and expectation, the season carries with it a penitential character of conversion and seeking the forgiveness of one's sins. The scripture readings of

Advent attest to this, especially as Jesus evokes the Flood of Noah's time (repentance and conversion before it is too late), St. Paul speaks of walking in the light of Christ rather than the darkness of sin (ongoing conversion and repentance after baptism), and St. John the Baptist calls for repentance because the Kingdom of God is at hand. Going to confession during this season is an essential way of preparing for the celebration of Christmas and part of our vigilance for the Lord's return at the end of time. To promote and support your participation in the spirituality of Advent, a confession schedule is found below.
