

Pentecost Sunday—is observed on the fiftieth day after Easter. We celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit bestowed upon the apostles as it is recounted in the Acts of the Apostles.

Pentecost is the birthday of the

Church and the fulfillment of Christ's promise that he would send the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, to his followers and the Church. Jesus and the Holy Spirit share a joint mission to bring to completion the work of salvation of Christ by the end of time.

The Holy Spirit has been poured forth generously into the Church to fulfill what Christ said, "As the Father has sent me, even so, I send you" (Jn 20: 21). Christ gives the Spirit to build, animate and sanctify (make holy) the Church (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 747) and to nourish, heal, organize, give life and send forth the members of his Church (Catechism, 739).

As we give thanks for the gift of the Holy Spirit today and celebrate his manifold works, reflect upon your own experience of the Spirit given to you through the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. The abundance of God's love has been manifested in your life! Live in and share what the Spirit has given to you.
